

Sacrament of Baptism: Baptisms are scheduled once a month following the 11:00 AM Mass. Please contact the Rectory for more information or to schedule a baptism for your child. Please note that godparents must be practicing Catholics who have made their confirmation. A certificate of eligibility from the godparent's parish must be attained.

Faith Formation: The education of our children in the life-giving truths of our Faith is the heart of our mission as a parish. Faith Formation classes for all grade levels will now be held on Sunday mornings at 10:00 AM between our two masses. Sacramental Preparation for First Reconciliation, First Communion, and Confirmation are 2 year programs. Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA): Are you interested in becoming a Catholic? RCIA is a process for becoming a fully initiated member of the Catholic Faith. It is for those who are seeking Baptism in the Catholic Faith, those who have been baptized in another Christian tradition and now seek to be a member of the Catholic Faith, and for those who have been baptized Catholic but have not received the Sacraments of Confirmation & Eucharist.
